Materials accepted:

- *All plastic bottles and their lids
- *Glass jars & bottles
- *Aluminum & steel cans
- *Empty aerosol cans with lids and tips removed
- *Paper bags
- *Computer paper & other mixed office paper
- *Corrugated cardboard, broken down to 3'X3'
- *Envelopes with & without windows
- *Junk mail
- *Magazines & phone books
- *Newspapers with inserts
- *Paperboard such as cereal boxes
- *Pizza boxes with all grease & food residue removed

Unacceptable items:

- *Plastics that are not bottles, such as dessert topping containers, butter tubs, or food trays
- *Plastic bags
- *Motor oil jugs or other chemical containers
- *Styrofoam
- *Lids/caps
- *Window or drinking glass
- *Light bulbs
- *Coat hangers or steel scrap
- *Paint cans

Plastic shopping bags

Shopping bags are marked with recycling information,

PLEASE TAKE THEM BACK TO THE STORE FOR RECYCLING!

The companies that recycle the bags need this plastic to be collected separate and kept clean from other recycled materials. You can also include clear, plastic packaging from non-food items (toilet paper, packs of water bottles, etc.) for recycling at stores as well.

Special Collection Days

Special collection days are one-day events for the collection of items that cannot be placed in recycling bins.

E-waste: computers, TVs, electronics

HHW – household hazardous waste: paint, oil, pesticides, solvents, mercury

Prescription/Medicine Disposal

DO NOT FLUSH ANY MEDICINES DOWN TOILET OR DRAINS

Expired/Unused Medicines: prescription, over the counter, pet medicines

Medicines may end up in the water supply!

The Union County Jail has a drop box inside the west front entrance. The public can safely dispose of unused medicines in this secure location 24 hours a day.

No needles are collected at this location. Ask the jailer for questions.
